



ENROL TO VOTE

Enrol to vote for the 2017 locally elected board member elections.

Local Land Services is encouraging ratepayers to enrol for the 2017 local elections. In 2017, Local Land Services will hold elections for locally elected board members. One ratepayer from each holding is eligible to enrol to vote.

Three of the seven local board members or four in the Western region, representing Local Land Services on local boards, are elected by ratepayers who have enrolled to vote.

Enrolling and voting ensures strong local representation, which helps to ensure local boards are representing the needs of ratepayers.

Ratepayers must enrol before being able to vote in the elections. Enrolling will ensure that you will be able to vote at election time. It only takes a few minutes and all you need is your Customer or Holding Reference Number.

People who have previously enrolled to vote in the Local Land Services elections do not have to enrol again.

Eligibility

Enrolment is voluntary.

Only one person is eligible to be enrolled representing each holding within a region. If you own a holding in a different region you are also eligible to vote in that region.

A person can be enrolled if:

- the holding consists wholly or partly of rateable land
- the person is an individual who is 18 or more years old.

The following persons may be enrolled in respect of a holding:

- an individual who is the only occupier of the holding
- if more than one individual is the occupier of a holding - the individual nominated to represent the holding
- in the case where the occupier of the holding is a corporation, the individual who has been nominated to represent the holding by the corporation.

A person can only be enrolled to vote once in each region.

Definitions

Holding – means a wholly or partly rateable parcel of land, or several parcels of land which are contiguous with one another or are separated from one another only by a road, river, creek or other watercourse, and constitute or are worked as a single property, irrespective of whether those parcels are held under the same title or different titles or titles of different kinds or whether they are in the same region.

Occupier – the person for the time being entitled to possession of land and includes, if the person so entitled does not reside on the land, the resident manager or other person in charge of the land.

Enrolments close on 31 March 2017.
