The workshop looked at what to consider when buying pasture and legume seed such as hard seededness, seed coatings, rhizobia etc as well as exploring the different growth patterns, flowering times of pastures, climate change impacts and genetic potential. The three hour workshop provided the myriad of options to consider to decide what to sow and when to sow, appropriate for one's farm. **Pasture Recovery Workshop in Central Coast October 2020**

After the many challenges from 2019-2020 such as drought, bushfires, flooding and a pandemic, this workshop guided graziers on the key steps to follow for pasture recovery. Seventeen landholders from the Central Coast attended this workshop presented by pastures expert, Clare Edwards, delivered on a private property in Ravensdale on 20 October 2020. The attendees learned how to assess pasture composition and condition, monitor pastures, deal with bare soil or poor ground cover and pasture management options.
