LOCAL LAND SERVICES ACT 2013 – SECTION 152 (1)

Data required from applicants wishing to obtain a permit to move a declared pest animal that has been trapped for the purpose of destruction as per the Pest Control Order.

SCHEDULE

A. MOVEMENT BY VEHICLE.

1. The declared pest must be transported by vehicle directly to the place of destination.
2. The declared pest must be transported in a secure crate or cage trap
3. The permit holder must provide a copy of this permit to any person involved in the movement of the declared pest.
4. The permit holder must keep records for the movement of the declared pest including the date, number and description of the declared pest to be made available to Stock Inspectors on request. These records and this permit are to be kept for a period of three years from the date of issue of the permit.
