#### 4. - Presentation - Draft Local Land Services Amendment Bill 2016 - Geoff Forster (Hunter LLS)

Presentation on the draft amendments provided. Item raised and discussed include:

- What is required in the codes for cultural heritage
- What triggers an additional investigation
- Due diligence assessment training for staff to provide skills in when additional investigation is necessary and:
  - o Ensure staff are aware and can communicate to the land holders
  - o Ensure staff are skilled in identifying cultural landscape features.

# 5. - Department of Planning's Guidelines for Economic Sustainability for assessments - Suzie Worth

Guidelines circulated with Agenda prior to meeting.

Discussion items:

- Draft Guidelines for economic assessment October 2015 placed on public exhibition
- Draft Guidelines in use by consultants and Community asked to comment on cultural significance detailed in a report utilising the Economic Assessment methodology
- The methodology required the site to be ranked on the scale of significance, concern raised that the ranking does not adequately capture the significance.

Action: Write a letter to Department of Planning and Office of Environment and Heritage about guidelines and ask:

- Why community was not consulted re the document?
- Why are archeologists already using it?

#### 6. - HLLS Indigenous Fire Knowledge Conference - August 2016

ACAG asked if they supported community attending the fire conference and how community should be selected. ACAG advised:

- Conference is key to further advance those currently undertake training
- Diploma students
- Open expression of interest to ALMTs Diploma students in Lower Hunter followed by ALMT'S in other districts where spots not filled.
- Ensure Diploma students respect local protocols
