Snapshots



We had a great roll up of 24 landholders at Gundagai for the first PROGRAZE workshop held in the Riverina since 2016. This is the first session from a total of eight to be held between September 2022 to 30 June 2023.



A population of rare native yam daisies has been discovered near Hay, with work underway from Riverina Local Land Services to protect the native plant. These plants would have been more widespread in the Riverina Rangelands prior to European use (grazing) of the stock routes.



After a two-year break due to COVID restrictions, the 2022 Henty Machinery Field Days was the biggest and most successful on record, with the Local Land Services team meeting with more than 6,000 of the record-breaking 70,000 visitors to the three-day event.
