

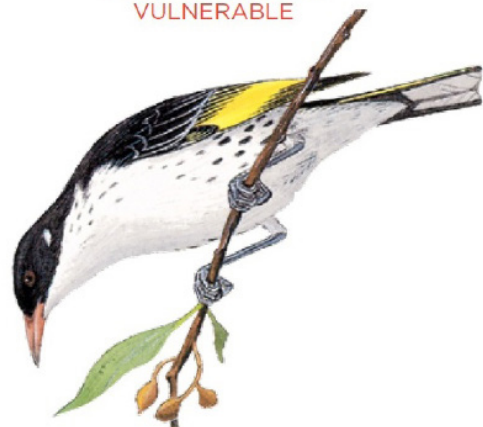
# 32 Woodland Birds of the Hunter Region

**Our woodland birds are in decline.** Across eastern Australia **over 50** woodland bird species have been identified for urgent conservation action. In the Hunter Valley and surrounds some of the most important woodlands and forests are known to support 32 of the 50 woodland birds in decline. **Do your bit!** Retain or encourage shrubby understorey, trees, native mistletoe and native grass on your property. Retain dead trees, woody debris and logs. Manage stock access. Protect woodlands and forests from fires and control weeds. Replant clearings with native species and expand habitats. **Protect our woodland birds and their habitats now!**

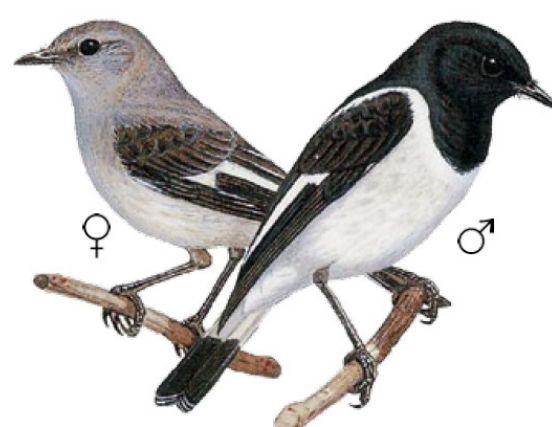

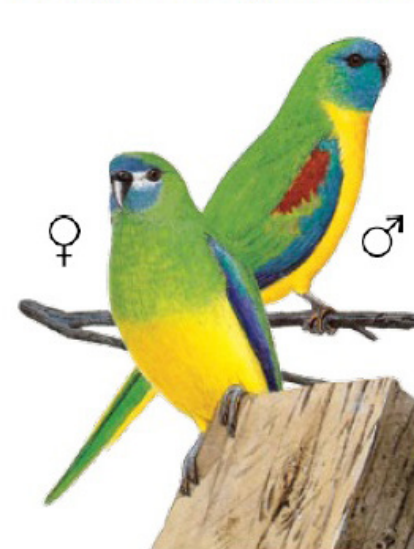

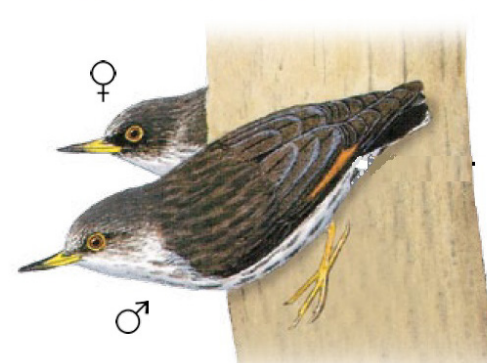

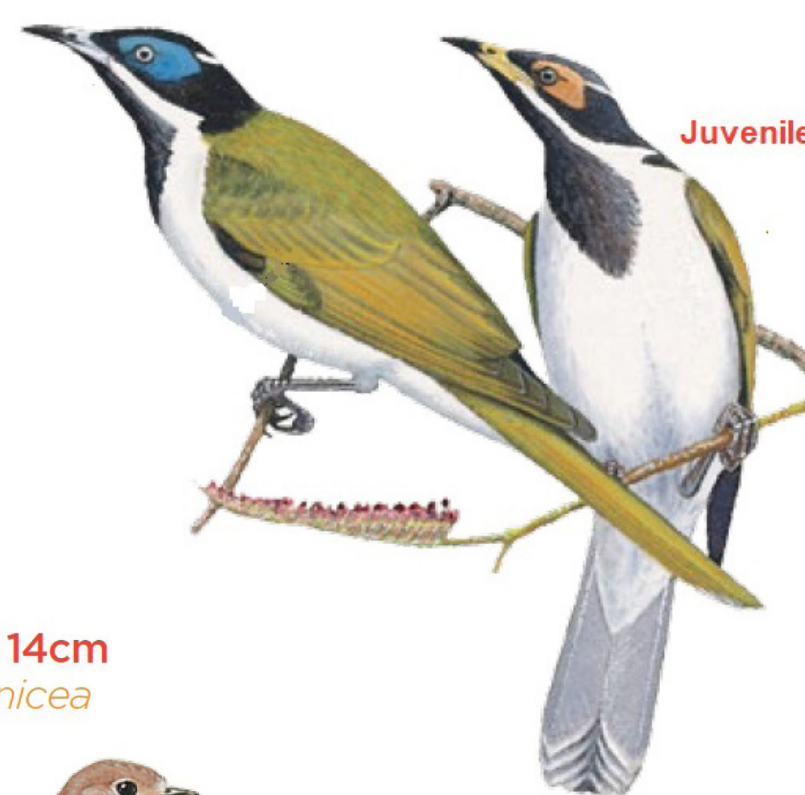

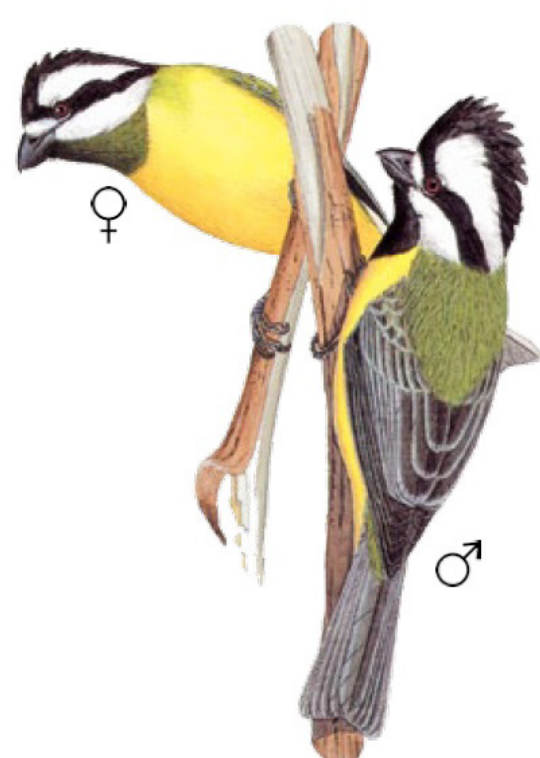

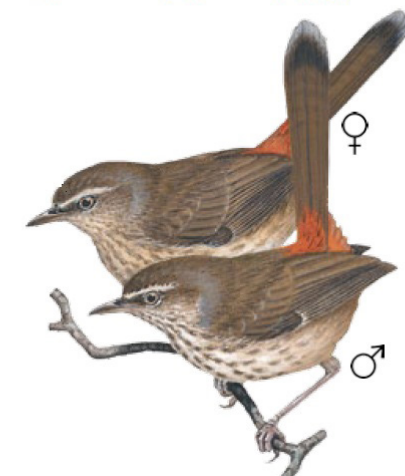

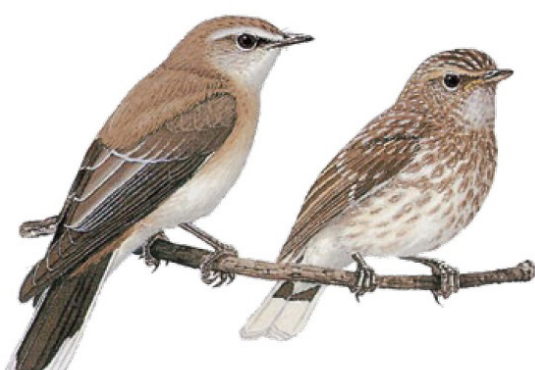

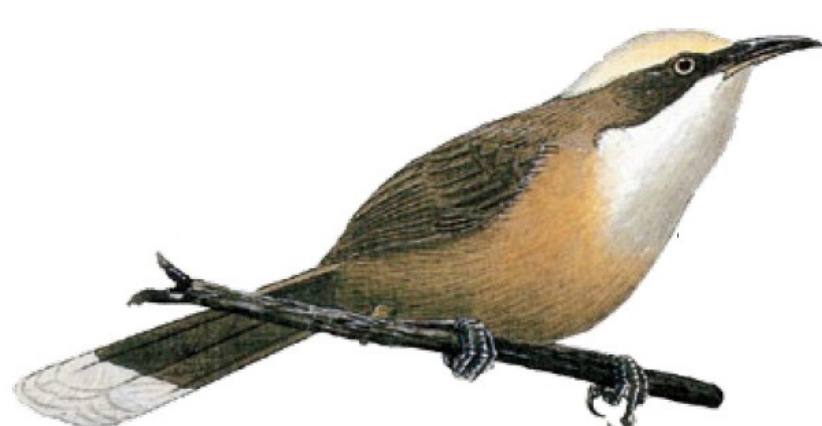
