

Apps for Landholders

LandSmart app - provides information about smart land management practices on rural properties to help land managers - particularly city-based landholders - look after their land sustainably and responsibly.

NSW DPI Drought feeding app - provides estimated energy, protein and dry matter values for 71 different feeds, including hay, grain, silage and alternative feeds. Farmers can easily assess the value of different feeds by simply comparing these results for three feeds as well a mixed ration.

NSW WeedWise - provides key information to help users reduce the impact of weeds in New South Wales (NSW). The app profiles over 300 weeds, describing biosecurity duties under the NSW Biosecurity Act 2015, control information and registered herbicide options.

Feral Scan - can be used at any time to record the location of pest animals in your local area, record the problems they are causing, and record control actions you undertake.

Field Guide to Pest Animals of Australia - Developed by the Invasive Animals CRC, this App contains species profiles for 53 of Australia's worst pest animals, including: species descriptions, photo galleries, footprints, audio calls, maps, control techniques, quick links to plenty of pest control resources.

FarmBiosecurity app - for people on the go who want to bolster biosecurity on their farm.

BOM Weather - is the Bureau of Meteorology's weather app, giving you the most accurate weather information at your fingertips.

MLA app - Get the latest market news and intelligence on the beef, sheep and goat industries direct from the source.

Veterinary Handbook - for cattle, sheep and goats is a comprehensive, mobile resource for veterinarians, animal health professionals, livestock producers, livestock handlers and veterinary and agricultural students.
