



AS A LANDHOLDER, CONTROLLING FOXES IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

Biosecurity Risk

Foxes are a priority pest animal in the Hunter Region because of the negative impact they have on agricultural and natural environments. Foxes occur in all areas of NSW across all landscape types. Under the *NSW Biosecurity Act 2015* every landholder has a General Biosecurity Duty (GBD) to reduce risks caused by foxes by undertaking control activities.

How do I know if foxes are present?

To determine if foxes are present look for visible sightings day and night, fresh scats and tracks, missing/dead animals such as chickens and dens.

Follow the steps below if you believe foxes to be on your property
