Insurance / Responsibility

- 1. Successful applicants must be able to provide a copy of a current, certified AQF3 chemical user's certificate for all persons carrying out herbicide control under this program.
- 2. It is the landholder's responsibility to hold and maintain Public Liability and Worker Compensation where applicable.

Guidelines

Activities NOT eligible for funding

- Statutory weed control
- Clearing of native vegetation
- Activities that have already been completed
- Chemical will not be supplied to contractors or sub-contractors on behalf of landholders

Activities eligible for funding

- Establishment of containment zones outside core infestations of Hudson Pear to maintain or progressively shrink containment lines or manage new outbreaks.
- Local eradication of outlier incursions in strategic locations
- Core infestation area: assist landholders to create buffer zones around high spread risk zones or pathways on their property such as roads/tracks, infrastructure and property boundaries.

To be eligible you must:

- 1. Be able to demonstrate that proposed activities are over and above any statutory landholder requirements for weed management under the Biosecurity Act 2015
- 2. Be willing to agree to enter into an Agreement for the provision of herbicide

Approved landholders will be required to pick up chemical from designated locations within agreed timeframes. North West Local Land Services staff will not act as delivery agents for landholders and maintain the right to refuse service or access to chemical at their discretion.
