**Written questions have character limits so that answers are not excessively lengthy. As you type, the application form will tell you how many characters are remaining.**

**Some questions must be answered to proceed with your application. We strongly advise filling out all questions to maximise our ability to assess your project.**

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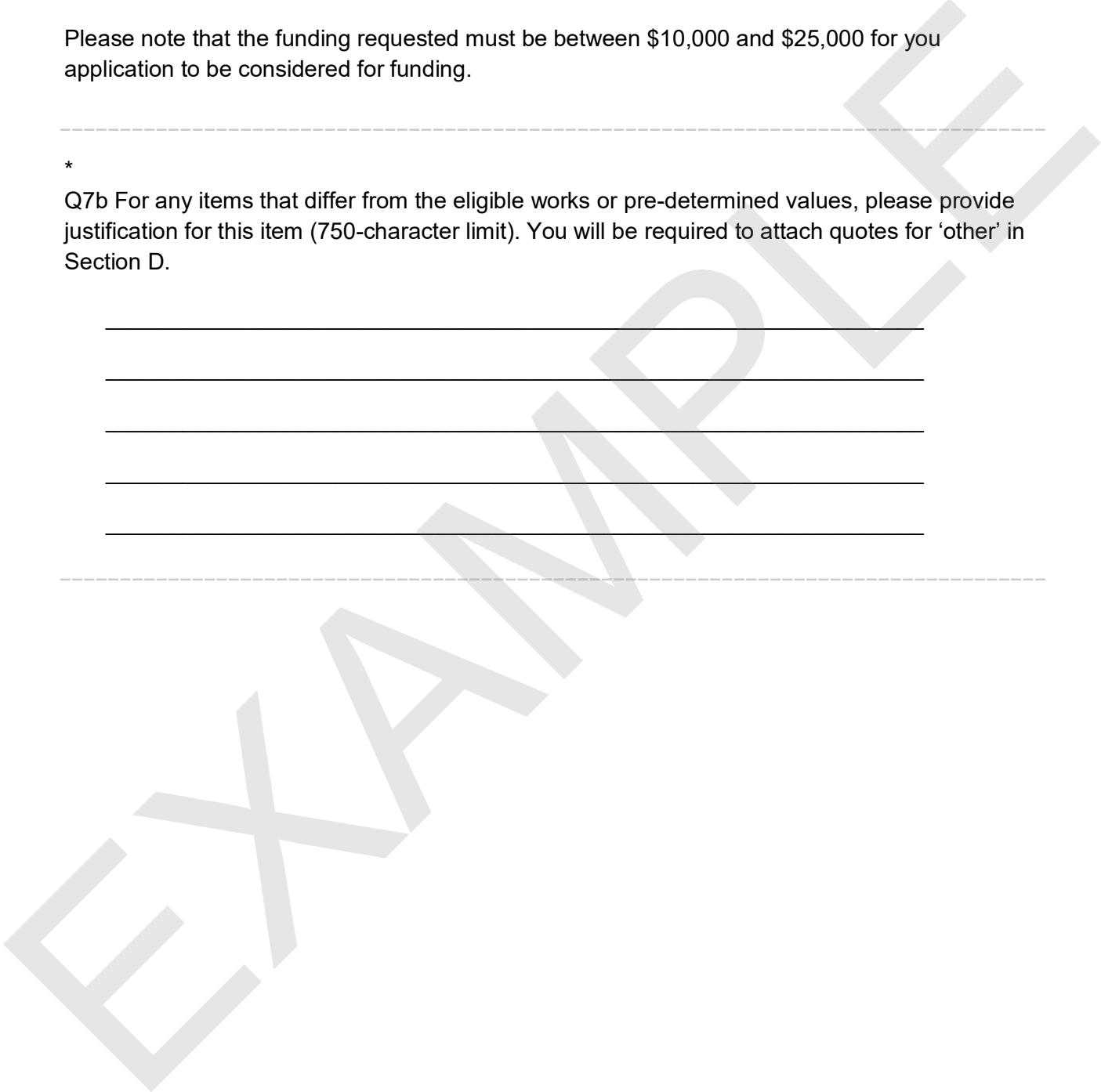
