This certificate is issued by Local Land Services pursuant to Part 5A Division 5 of the *Local Land Services Act* 2013

Clearing in accordance with the conditions set out in Schedule 2 of this certificate is conclusively presumed to be clearing in accordance with the following provisions of the Code for the purposes of section 60Z(2) of the Local Land Services Act 2013: clauses 82-85.

Local Land Services certifies the intended clearing complies with the terms of the relevant Division of the Land Management (Native Vegetation) Code 2018 if the clearing of native vegetation and management of set asides is carried out in accordance with conditions, management obligations and the Certificate Treatment Area Map and the Certificate Set Aside Area Map set out in this certificate. All landowners and landholders must comply with the relevant Division and Parts of the Land Management (Native Vegetation) Code 2018 and the requirements set out in the schedules of this certificate.

Note: Activities undertaken in accordance with this certificate may require authorisation under other legislation.

Interpretation of key words and phrases

The words and phrases that are defined in the *Local Land Services Act 2013, Local Land Services Regulation 2014, Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* or Land Management (Native Vegetation) Code 2018 have the same meaning in this certificate unless otherwise defined.

Treatment areas means all treatment areas specified in the Certificate Treatment Area Map for this certificate. Set aside areas means all set aside areas shown in the Certificate Set Aside Area Map for this certificate.



General conditions

- This certificate does not authorise clearing of native vegetation that forms part of Critically Endangered Ecological Community.
- 2. This certificate does not authorise any clearing of native vegetation outside the treatment area as shown on the Certificate Treatment Area Map.
- 3. In the course of carrying out clearing that is authorised by this certificate, the person who carries out the clearing must not harm an animal that is a threatened species if that person knew that the clearing was likely to harm the animal.
- 4. A notification may not be made over land that is an existing treatment area under any Division of the Code
- 5. This certificate does not authorise forestry operations within the meaning of section 3 of the *Forestry Act 2012*. (This does not prevent the sale of timber from native vegetation lawfully cleared in accordance with the Code).

Note: A land management (native vegetation) code does not permit clearing or any other activity without the prior written consent of:

- (a) in the case of land that is not Crown land all owners of the land, or
- (b) in the case of Crown land the Minister administering the Crown Land Act 1989.

Note: A land management (native vegetation) code does not permit clearing or any other activity:

- (a) without an approval or other authority required by or under another Act or another Part of the Local Land Services Act 2013, or
- (b) in contravention of any provision of or made under another Act or another Part of the Local Land Services Act 2013.



Schedule 1

Term of certificate

This certificate has effect in perpetuity from the date of issue.

Note: A certificate may be revoked or surrendered with approval of Local Land Services pursuant to section 60Y of the *Local Land Services Act 2013*.

Re-categorisation of land

In accordance with section 60K(3)(e) of the *Local Land Services Act 2013* the treatment area as shown in the Certificate Treatment Area Map is authorised to be re-categorised as Category 1 – exempt land.
