# 2022 East Coast Floods Emergency Response Grant Program

The ILSC

If you are an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Corporation directly impacted by the recent flood disaster or assisting with recovery, you may be able to access a grant of up to \$20,000 (GST excl.) through the Indigenous Land and Sea Corporation's 2022 East Coast Floods Emergency Response Grant.

### Assistance Available

- The ILSC is making grants available to any Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Corporation whose property has been directly affected by the recent flood disaster, or Indigenous groups who are assisting the immediate recovery and clean-up efforts on Indigenous-held lands.
- A grant of up to \$20,000 (GST exclusive) per entity could be available to assist either:
  - 1. Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Corporations to immediately secure and clean-up loss or damage to their property; or
  - 2. Indigenous groups who have a land- or water-based business and who are assisting (whether paid or not) with immediate recovery and clean-up efforts
- The amount of each grant will be determined based on the immediate recovery efforts required and the costs of these efforts but will not exceed \$20,000 (GST exclusive).
- The Program is open until 15 June 2022. The ILSC will review community need at this time and may decide to extend the Program.

### Eligibility

- An Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Corporation may be eligible if:
  - Its property is within the flood disaster zone, as declared by their relevant State and Territory (<u>NSW</u> and <u>QLD</u> or refer to Appendix for list); and
  - o Its property was affected by floods since 22 February 2022; and
  - o It requires immediate assistance to make their property safe to access.
- Other Indigenous groups may be eligible if:
  - o Its core business is land or water-based; and
  - It is assisting (paid or volunteering) the clean-up of affected Indigenous-held property within the flood disaster zone affected (<u>NSW</u> and <u>QLD</u> or refer to Appendix for list).

# Use of Funding

- Funding can be used for:
  - Immediate clean-up of properties
  - Works to make properties safe
  - o Plant and equipment to support the recovery efforts
- Funding cannot be used for:
  - Repair and replacement of items that are covered under existing insurance policies unless there is a clear and urgent health and safety risk to humans and livestock.
  - o Any work that has already occurred


# Information Required

The ILSC requires the following information to make decisions about eligibility and to make payments efficiently:

- The name of the Corporation and who it is incorporated with
- The name and address of the property
- Confirmation of the applicant's authority to apply on behalf of their organisation
- Photos of property clean-up required and/or damage caused
- Information on what urgent recovery and/or clean-up work is needed
- Information on potential services and contractors to assist with the work, including quotes where available
- The Corporation or group's bank details and a document that confirms these details
