**My comments**

1. BUSHFIRES: The main thing that this code must include is to allow, actually mandate, the salvaging of the dead trees both standing and lying, from the bush in order to reduce the severity of the next bushfire. We need to leave some dead wood in the bush for the animals but not an increased amount after each bushfire. This is what is increasing the severity of bushfires. You only have to go for a bush walk to see the ever increasing amount of dead wood standing and lying everywhere. This dead wood should be removed from all forests, private, state and national. This rotting wood is also continually producing CO2. This dead wood produces the huge amounts of toxic smoke when it burns.
